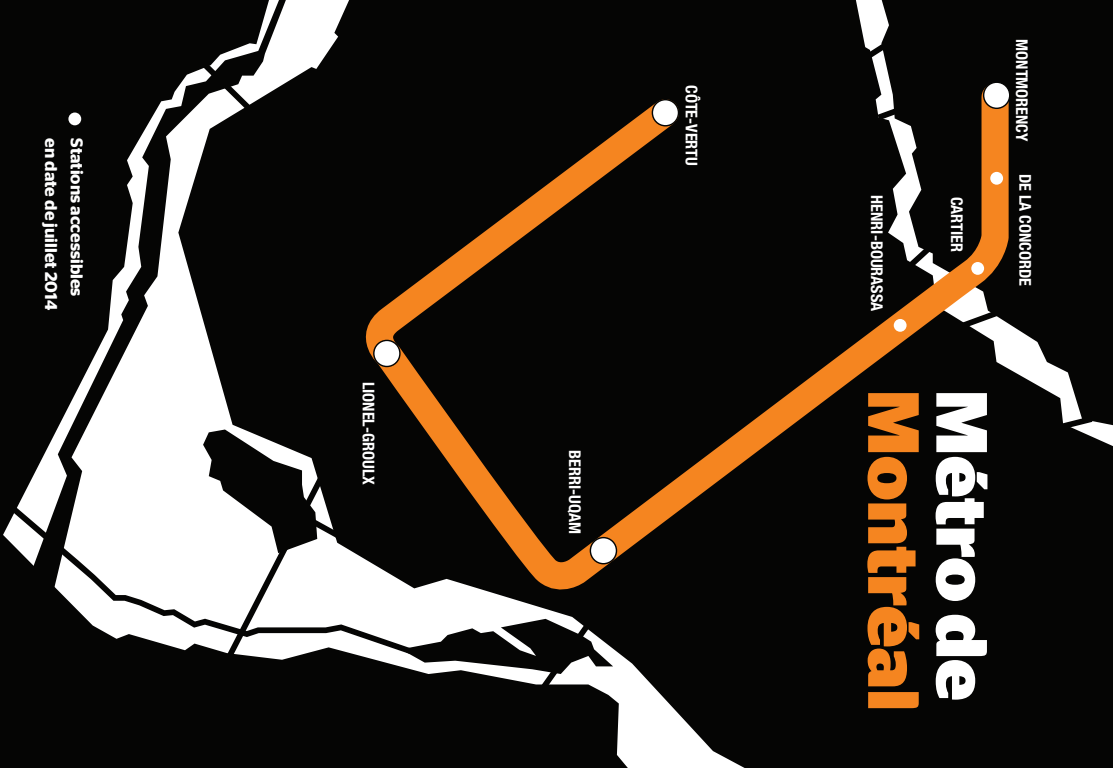

**Mr. Couillard,**

I am writing to call you to action in making public transit accessible in the City of Montreal.

Currently, seven metro stations out of 68 have elevators (only four of those stations are on the island of Montreal).

Serious barriers in accessing buses persist due to a lack of training, a lack of maintenance and a disregard for the rights of people with disabilities.

At the current rate, the Montreal metro system will be accessible by elevator in the year 2090.

Montreal is embarrassingly behind other major Western cities in terms of accessibility in public transit. Concrete and ambitious measures must be taken without delay, in order to rectify this.
